

# Why will my Cadac appliance bought in SA not work in the UK?

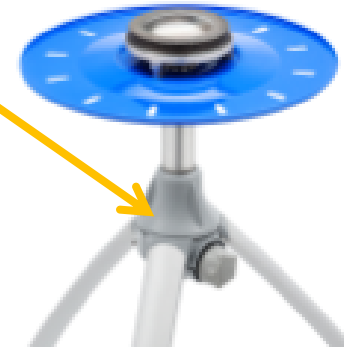
## 1. Gas Control Valve • Cylinder v Appliance

In South Africa the gas control valve is positioned on the cylinder (it's on the appliance in the UK) and the stem works on direct pressure screwing directly into the top of the SA cylinder.

## 2. Direct pressure (SA) v Regulated pressure (UK)

All gas cylinders in the UK are regulated to 28mbar butane, 37mbar propane.

This means that compared to UK the SA set up is at much higher pressure. This means the jets and burners on the appliance sold in the UK and SA are differently calibrated.



Direct pressure screwing direct onto the cylinder

**In South Africa the stem screws directly into the gas cylinder valve. In the UK the valve and burner are positioned on a tripod and stem.**

### • WHY?

**Gas regulations differ throughout the world**, in the UK the SA direct stem set up fails CE regulation topple tests hence the tripod and stem.

We cannot recommend a "simple work around" as this legally implies responsibility and to be quite honest there is no easy option. Cadac UK are very sorry that we cannot offer an immediate solution
